Subject: Leading the Way Award Winners – Spring 2021 Announcement

Dear Mayor Simison:

On behalf of ETC Institute, I want to congratulate the City of Meridian for winning our Leading the Way Award.

ETC Institute's "Leading the Way Award" was created to recognize local governments for outstanding achievement in the delivery of services to residents. Recipients of the award rank in the top 10% of all local governments in the United States with regard to their composite performance in three core areas that are assessed on ETC Institute's DirectionFinder® Survey:

- satisfaction with the overall quality of services
- satisfaction with customer service provided by employees, and
- satisfaction with the value residents think they receive for local taxes and fees.

A maximum of 100 points are awarded in each of these areas based on the results of the survey. In order to rank in the "Top 10% of All Cities", a city must have received a composite score of 210 or more, which means the city scored an average of at least 70 points in all three areas. The threshold of 210 was established using the results of surveys from more than 400 communities that have participated in ETC Institute's DirectionFinder® Survey over the past two years. The City of Meridian's composite rating was 241 which was 87 points above the average composite score of 154 for all cities in the United States.

The City of Meridian is truly setting standard in many areas. In addition to ranking in the top 10% overall, the City of Meridian also rated in the top 10% of all cities that participated in our DirectionFinder® between August 2020 and February 2021 in the areas listed below.

- · Enforcement of local codes and ordinances
- Overall quality of fire services
- The level of public involvement in decision making

- How quickly fire services personnel respond to emergencies
- Customer service provided by the City
- · Outdoor athletic fields
- Wastewater/sanitary sewer services
- · How quickly police respond to emergencies
- Maintenance of City parks
- · Youth recreation programs
- · Usefulness of the city's website
- Overall quality of emergency medical/ambulance services
- Fire education programs
- · Number of City parks

Since 1999, ETC Institute's DirectionFinder® Survey has been administered to nearly two million residents in all 50 states. Although ETC Institute has provided "benchmarking" data that has allowed communities, like Meridian, to compare your results with other communities for many years, ETC Institute did not formally recognize the top performers until 2020. The crystal award that you are receiving weighs 11 pounds to represent the 11 cities that participated in ETC Institute's DirectionFinder® Survey the first year the survey was conducted in 2000.
